VII. Director's Update

- a. Thank you to all the parents who went on the Disney trip. It was a mostly uneventful trip. There were no major injuries and everyone got back safely. The Band received a Disney trophy with the school and band name. It might be 3-4 years before the next one. Doing a Bands Of America competition in Orlando but that will be 3-4 years away.
- b. It is going to be a busy 10 weeks. All bands are getting ready for UIL sight reading and band contest. Pre-UIL contest is on March 29th. Wind Symphony will do their concert on Saturday in conjunction with the Wylie Community Band. WEHS is hosting this year. Itineraries will be sent out to Wind Symphony students. - c. Next week – WEHS is hosting the middle school UIL contest. The color guard will be at Coppell High School for WGI Dallas event. Then they will go to Lewisville for the championship competition. In April – band officers and drum majors for the 2022/2023 school year will be selected.
